**MTC Throws Support Behind Transportation Bond Measure**

San Francisco, Calif. (KCBS) -- After releasing the list of most congested Bay Area freeways, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission is throwing its support behind a transportation infrastructure bond.

MTC Freeway Congestion Hot Spots

The MTC's Scott Haggerty told KCBS' Melissa Culross that the transportation bond on the November ballot will help. "Over \$4 billion is earmarked for corridor mobility, which also is intended to address highly-congested corridors."

Haggerty added, "we know there's billions and billions of dollars out there in projects. We can't get to them. We can't get them done. This is a way to get California moving again. This is a way to get California working again."

However not everyone is a fan of the measure. On its website the Transportation and Land Use Coalition said building more roads is not a lasting solution to congestion, and the bond would just encourage more sprawl.
